## HAS YOUR BACKFLOW BEEN CERTIFIED?

You probably have at least one backflow device installed. These devices prevent bad water from flowing back into good water, helping to assure the good health of your employees and of the community in which you work. The federal and state EPA's mandate that these devices be tested and certified annually to insure proper operation. Taylor currently tests and certifies over 7000 backflow devices a year.

Now that spring has arrived in the Chicagoland area, its time to think about your landscaping. Taylor provides full service landscape irrigation service. This includes:

1. Spring turn-on, including repair of any damaged equipment.
2. Summer adjustment (optional). This involves changing the watering duration and frequency, as required by the hotter and longer days of summer.
3. Fall turn-off, including blowing the system dry to prevent winter damage.

**If it's raining and your irrigation system is watering your lawn, call Taylor.**

### Only 2 tools needed:

You need only two tools, namely WD-40 and duct tape.

If it doesn't move and it should, use WD-40.

If it moves and it shouldn't, use the tape.
